

**Articulation Agreement
Between
Labette Community College
And the
Donnelly College**

Labette Community College (LCC) and Donnelly College (DC) agree to work cooperatively to facilitate students' studies at LCC and subsequent transfer to DC to obtain a baccalaureate degree in Information Systems. Students will begin their studies at LCC in the Computer Science, A.S. program. When accepted into the program at LCC, students are encouraged to use the services of the DC Academic Director of Information Systems, who will facilitate the transfer process. The students need to be aware that the Bachelor of Science in Information Systems general education requirements may exceed those of the LCC A.S. program.


The Information Systems Transfer Guide (Appendix 1) lists those courses that are accepted for transfer by DC, provided the final grades meet prerequisite requirements.

The two institutions will each identify a liaison officer whose role will be to communicate with the other institution regarding procedures and requirements, curriculum matters, equivalent transfer credit, course equivalencies, course requirements, changes in personnel, and academic advisement as needed to operate the program. Written and telephone inquiries from students and staff of LCC will be welcomed by the liaison officer at DC so that students' questions can be answered prior to arrival at DC.

LCC agrees to take steps to make its students aware of the opportunities afforded by this articulation and will identify the Donnelly College Articulation Agreement in its catalogs. LCC also agrees to notify the DC liaison officer of any changes that influence the program.


This agreement is subject to an annual review by LCC and DC. Either party may discontinue this agreement by giving the other party notice twelve months in advance of its plans to discontinue. However, all students in the program will be allowed to complete their studies within a reasonable period of time. This agreement is not intended to confer enforceable rights on any third party.
